For a total of not fewer than 21 hours. Note: Courses may not “double count” on both a major and minor program. Certifiable.

For certification (as an add-on endorsement, known as Missouri ELL (English Language Learners) (K-12) Endorsement), the State of Missouri Dept. of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) requires:

1. The required courses as specified above.

2. A valid Missouri teacher’s certificate.

3. Professional Requirements.

A. Either SPE 310 Introduction to Special Education (3 hrs) F, S OR SPE 340 Educational Alternative for Exceptional Students (2 hrs) F, S and SPE 300 Service Learning in Special Education (1 hr) F, S **together**

B. RDG 474, Improving Reading in Secondary School Classrooms (3 hrs) F, S AND RDG 574, Analysis and Correction of Difficulties in Literacy (3 hrs) F, S

4. All students must have a 2.75 GPA or higher (MSU and transfer grades combined) in the certification subject area, which includes all courses required for the minor. A minimum grade of C or higher in each course listed above is required for certification.
